4	Dan's Update	Dan's update as per recent website reports. Change noted to the position WASC was reported to have come in the second round of the Crusader League. WASC actually came 2 nd not first as stated in the initial report. Team manager's observed that the very young swimmers, some of which had never swam in a gala, didn't know what to do, particularly those that had never swam in a relay. Suggestion was made that Alex Law practice with the Raptors to prepare for the final round.
5	Swim Camp 2018	The treasurer asked the committee their views on organising another swim-camp abroad in 2018, bearing in mind that at a previous committee meeting it was agreed that a swim-camp abroad would take place every other year in order to capture all swimmers at some point in their swim career. It was agreed in principle to take to the AGM in April, setting out clear guidelines on age and eligibility. For the Junior squads, those in Juggernauts not eligible, gold and silver will be invited to go to a 4 or 5 day camp at Kingham during the Easter holidays, coached by Alex Law and Nigel Woodbridge, team managers Sue Wright, Julie Grindley/Lucie George (tbc). It was agreed that to go forward in the organising of swim-camps a swim-camp committee be created, consisting of the following members: Helen Jones, Julie Grindley, Lucie George, Jayne Deeming, Claire Brown, Dave Moss and Diane Christopherson.
6	Poolside Passes	During galas, pool side marshals should wear a pass at all times, this pass is to be given to the next marshal when taking over the rest of the session. If you offer to be a marshal, can you please
