Role Overview

During competition, the Athlete Kit Team Members will work as a team under the guidance of the Athlete Kit Team Leader to move each athlete's kit from the starting blocks to the athlete kit collection area in an organised, timely manner. This ensures that the athletes can retrieve their items of kit post-race and that the competition schedule keeps on time to allow the next event to take place.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- 1. Attend team briefings at the start of shifts and de-briefs at the end of the shifts
- 2. Retrieving and carrying the Athletes' kit boxes from the pool deck during each race
- 3. Returning the boxes to the kit collection area
- 4. Collecting Athletes' accreditation from the final call room and moving it to the accreditation table
