Role Overview

The Athlete Kit Team Leader will lead the team of young volunteer Athlete Kit Team members who are responsible for the crucial task of preparing, collecting, maintaining and safeguarding the athletes' kits during the competition sessions. The Athlete Kit Team move every athlete's kit from the starting blocks to the athlete kit collection area in an organised, timely manner. This ensures that the athletes can retrieve their items of kit post-race and that the competition schedule keeps on time to allow the next event to take place.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

- 1. Report any attrition at the start of the shift to the FOP Team Leader
- 2. Be responsible for the Athlete Kit Team while they are at the competition venue
- 3. Ensure the Athlete Kit Team operate their kit collection as efficiently and timely as possible
- 4. Post-session gather any lost property and pass it onto Sport Information desk
